Any of the following types of misconduct during CTFK participation may result in removal from office.

- Showing disrespect to adults or fellow students
- Vulgar or profane language
- Fighting
- Lewd or otherwise inappropriate behavior
- Not maintaining a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or mood-altering substances OR attending at functions where such substances are present
- Any other activity that could bring discredit to CTFK,
  - Including inappropriate or disrespectful use of Social Media (eg. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Snapchat, etc.)

As specified in the CTFK Constitution, there are 3 monthly meetings. Attendance at these meetings is mandatory. If a student is unable to attend, he/she must notify the Chief Executive Officer. One or more absences may be grounds for dismissal.

Infractions to the above rules, and rules listed for CTFK sponsored activities will be reviewed by the Chief Executive Officer and CTFK Executive Board and may be grounds for dismissal.
